The Kalihi YMCA has been serving our neighborhood since 1946. Kalihi Y is part of the Honolulu YMCA which has been serving Hawai'i since 1869. The YMCA has nine facilities on O'ahu.

Our over-all mission is to assist children and teenagers to develop a healthy body, mind and spirit by providing recreational and educational opportunities and by helping them to change behaviors that are causing them problems.

In 1962, the board of the Kalihi Y founded the first outreach program to work with gang members in Honolulu. Over time, this program has added adolescent substance abuse programs funded by the Family Court and the Office of Youth Services. The Kalihi Y has expanded its services throughout the island of O'ahu. The Kalihi Y also operates school-based substance abuse programs, funded by the state Alcohol and Drug Abuse Branch of the Department of Health, at several O'ahu high schools.
